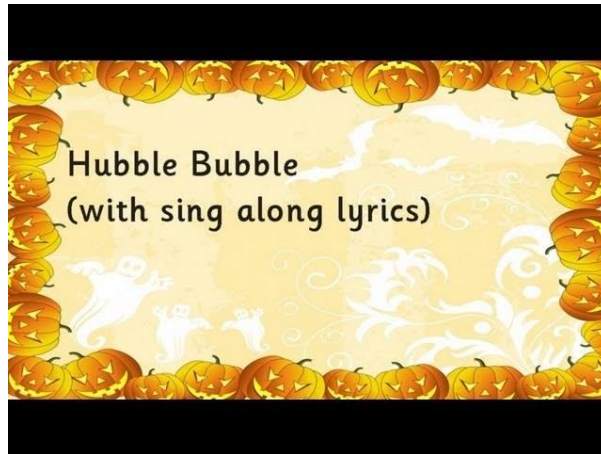


1 - This month we begin the theme of 'myself', getting to know each other and family members.

At Ravenscroft, we use Microsoft Sway to make a lot of our digital information resources. The benefit of this is that any updates are autosaved and viewable in real time so we can add or amend documents without re issuing you a link, the original one will automatically contain updates.

We usually use a horizontal read option, though depending on which device you read it on so just make sure that you've been able to access all of the information included. At the top right hand side of each sway is a cog symbol, you can use this to change the layout so for

example if your phone has defaulted to top to bottom layout, you may see more information by clicking on the cog icon and switching to the horizontal reading option.

Desktop/laptops and iPads generally stick to the layout we have composed the document.

We have tried to use a layout that reduces the need to click to read a pop up piece of text going forward.

We are happy to help you with any questions or queries about this.

We do encourage you to go back and take another look at the useful information sway we sent out on seesaw at the beginning of the school year, in case this helps you to pick up anything you may have missed first time around:

Morning room will begin on Monday, the 20th of October. The voluntary donation cost will be £1 per day, and it will be from 8:30-8:55am. The voluntary donation helps to cover the cost of the staffing, the allocated funding from DE isn't enough alone to cover the costs so it's important that we receive enough in donations to keep the service running until the end of the school year.

Your child **MUST** be fully settled before using this service, it is manned by one staff member only.

Children **MUST** be brought down to the staff room and handed over into the care of the staff member, use the buzzer in the hall to gain access in the mornings when you arrive.

Also, it's essential to sign up in advance, even if you only plan to use the service occasionally, it helps us to know if our staffing ratio is adequate.

Please, if you arrive at 8.55am or later, go to the gate on Uniondale Street, staff won't be able to take children in between 8.55am and 9.00 am. Please do let anyone dropping your child into school know this as well, it saves any confusion.

We will be going to the [Walkway Centre](#) every Monday, starting the 10th of November and running until the end of June. We will walk the children over with their class groups and

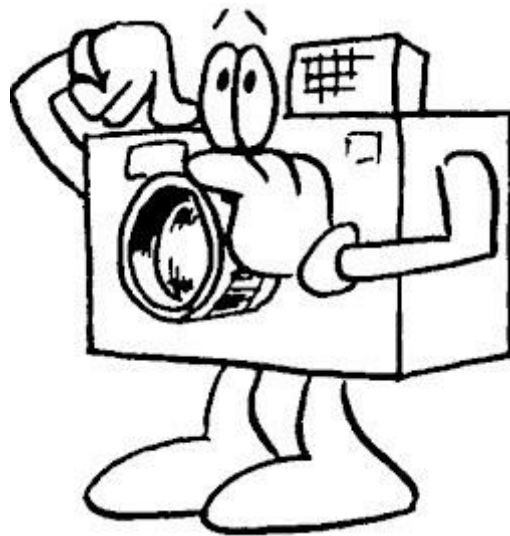

Seesaw is a great way to contact us about general enquiries. This account is set up on Mrs Symington's name but all staff can use it- this means that seesaw will automatically attach only Mrs Symington's name to any messages you receive through the mailbox function.

All staff have an emoji/icon that they use when signing off, so you know who has sent out any messages you receive. We also use them when posting on your child's seesaw journal.



Miss Louise McCullough will be your point of contact for any money related queries so school fund, dinners, uniforms, photos or anything else.

When making any payments using bank transfer it's essential that you can add in your child's name and some reference to let us know what the money is for, otherwise it just a guess for us and we may not allocate the payment correctly which can lead to confusion.

We prefer it if no cash is sent to school but know it's not always possible. Staff won't be able to take cash from you - we'll ask you to place any cash you are giving to school into a blue RNS envelope. You will need to write clearly on this who it's from, what it's for and how much it is. We have a red, locked postbox in the hall for each class, the envelope must be placed into this box. It will be your responsibility to ensure that it goes in there clearly marked if you choose to use cash. Just ask if you need help with this.

We really do appreciate all of your efforts to support us in managing and accounting for payments and monies coming into the school, thank you.

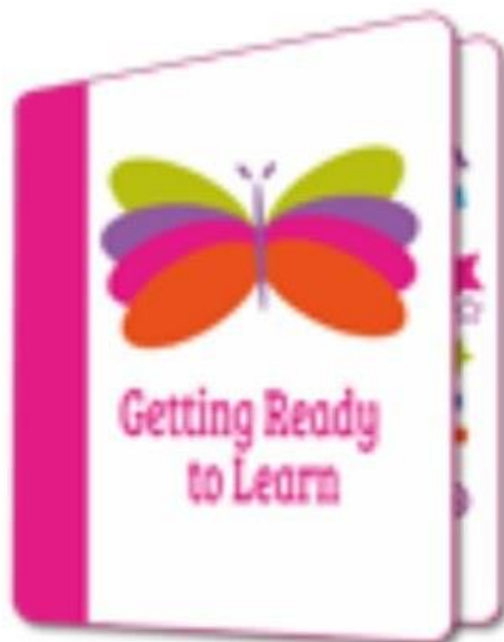
