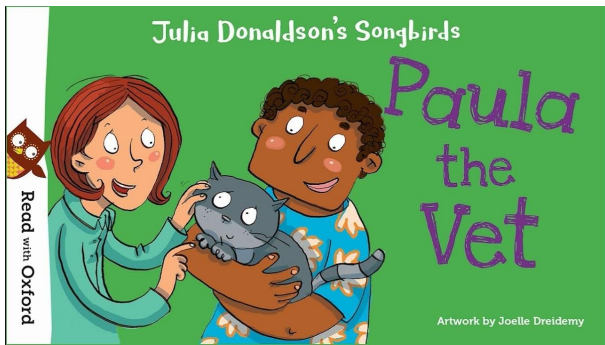
All staff have an emoji/icon that they use when signing off, so you know who has sent out any messages you receive. We also use them when posting on your child's journal.

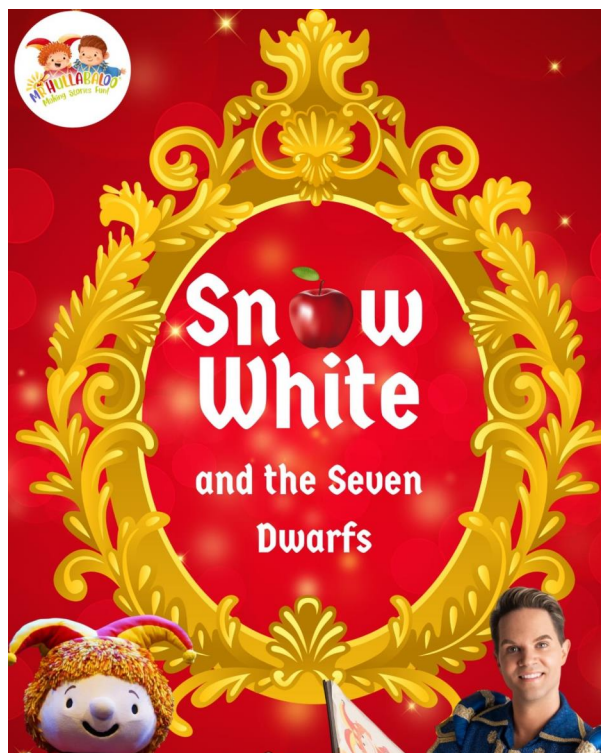
December 2nd - Ellie the Elf comes for Story Time

Our annual Santa Trail takes place on 11th December.

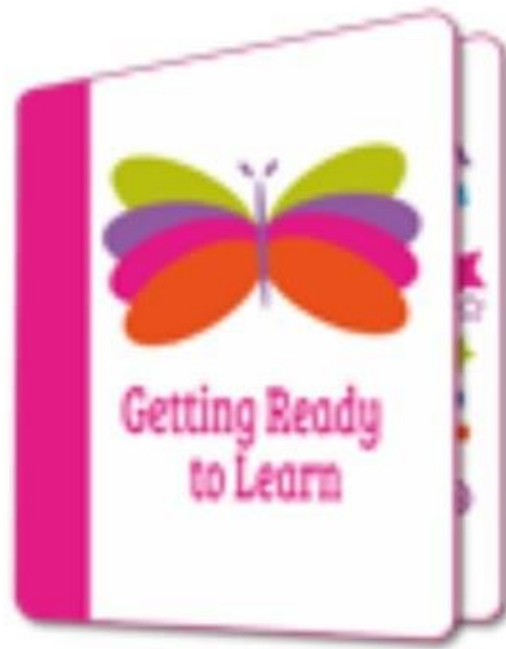
Please book your free ticket in advance so we can make sure we have fully catered for the event.
